Collection of your personal information

We may collect personal information from you directly. We may also collect such information through third parties who approach us on your behalf. This may include your employees or business associates, our contractors, brokers or introducers, advisers such as lawyers and accountants and any other person authorised by you. We may also collect personal information as a result of you accessing our web page or portal (including by the use of cookies).

The collection of certain personal information including information used to verify your identity is required by law (including to meet our obligations under the *Anti-Money Laundering and Counter Terrorism Financing Act 2006 (Cth)*).

Uses of your personal information

Failure to provide personal information



If you do not provide us with the personal information we ask for, or the information provided is incorrect or incomplete, we may not be able to provide you with our products or services.

Disclosures of your personal information to third parties

We may disclose your personal information to the following persons or organisations for the purposes described above:

- our employees, contractors or external service providers for the operation of our websites or our business, fulfilling requests by you, and otherwise in connection with providing our products and services to you;
- our existing or potential agents, business partners or joint venture entities or partners (including for clarity as part of a corporate transaction such as a fund raising, merger or sale of shares or assets);

- any other organisation as expressly covered in our Privacy Policy.
